Date & State of Your Soul: Jot down the date and describe your present emotions/feelings/temperament in a word or two. Notice how you feel before reading the bible vs. how you feel upon finishing.

Verse(s): Write out a piece of biblical text from your reading. It can be whatever stuck out to you the most!

Context: Challenge yourself to think of the bigger picture – who wrote that particular piece of text? Who was speaking to whom? When was it written? Why? [Google is not off limits here. *Just sayin'*.]

Key-words: Sometimes when you're reading scripture a single word can have a huge impact. Record whatever word or theme is jumping out at you.

Takeaways: Be radically transparent with yourself by asking questions, and evaluating yourself against Jesus' nature. Where do you see your own wrong-doing and how can you make it right? OR Where are you finding yourself in complete awe and worship of God? Write that revelation down!

Application: Based on your takeaway, how are you going to translate that thought into your daily life? Get specific – name the person, thing, or situation that came to mind.

Prayer: Close by going to God in confession, repentance, praise, worship – whatever is on your heart. Ask Him to give you strength and power in bringing your application to fruition.

However you make it work, my hope is that these sheets will help structure and deepen your time in the word, while strengthening your relationship with God.
